

HRH TUANKU SYED FAIZUDDIN MAKING A DIFFERENCE WITH 'KAYUHAN MAIPS PEDULI' PROGRAMME.

KANGAR 22 Nov. – Crown Prince of Perlis, HRH Tuanku Syed Faizuddin Putra Jamalullail leads 167 program participants of 'Kayuhan Peduli Perlis Islamic Religion and Malay Customs Council (MAIPs) to visit the asnaf (eligible tithe recipients) here today. The cycling starts at 8.30 am from Putra Mosque and ends at 'Perkampungan Sunnah' Volume II 2015, Alwi Mosque in Kangar today. The program entered its 100th series today since its launch in 2012.
